

The Art of Dario Fo and Franca Rame

The National Gallery of Ancient Art hosts an event to remember Dario Fo and Franca Rame, two of the most important artists at national and international level, who have scored over half a

century of Italian cultural and theatrical history. The exhibition will be open from March 24th to June 25th at the Palazzo Barberini and will celebrate the salient episodes of their artistic career and the political-historical relevance of the time. The exhibition traces the story of the artists in a maze of about 150 works including drawings, paintings, tapestries, scripts, photos, documents, puppets, masks, costumes and props.
